

SSAC2 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Your new SHORE STATION SSAC2 ELECTRIC DRIVE is universal and will fit most boat hoists manufactured that are equipped with a large hand wheel.

SHORE STATION ALUMINUM MODELS



1. Position the mounting bracket (Ref. #20) with the notch on the upright post just below the winch case. Secure to post with large 3/8" (Ref. #3) round U-bolts and lock nuts (Ref. #10). Tighten to hold in position.

2. Insert 3/8" square U-bolt (Ref. #4) into mounting bracket


and secure with 3/8" lock nuts (Ref. #10). Slide aluminum spacer bar (Ref. #17) into square U-bolts.

3. Fasten mounting arm (Ref. #8) to drive unit with 5/16" x 1" head bolts and 5/16" lock nuts. Slip mounting arm into 3/8" square u-bolts making sure the aluminum spacer bar is behind the mounting arm (Ref. #8) next to mounting channel (Ref. #20) as shown in the above picture. Operate lever to place motor and pulley into the disengaged position. With motor in the disengaged position, slide the mounting arm through the U-bolts with the motor positioned to the right as you face the hand wheel until there is approximately 1/2" clearance between the outer most diameter of the large hand wheel and the bottom of the pulley groove. Tighten 3/8" square U-bolts. (Note: The bracket installed in step one may need to be rotated on the upright post so the large hand wheel and pulley groove align with one another.)

4. Engage the grooved pulley with the hand wheel. If pulley and hand wheel do not contact sufficiently the complete unit can be moved closer to the hand wheel by loosening 3/8" square U-bolts in step 3, then repositioning

and tightening.

SHORE STATION STEEL MODELS



1. Position the mounting bracket (Ref. #20) with the notch on the tube above the winch case. Secure with the small 3/8" round Ubolts and lock nuts.

2. Insert the 3/8" square U-bolts (Ref. #4) into mounting bracket and secure with 3/8" lock nuts

(Ref. #10). Slide aluminum spacer bar (Ref. #17) into square U-bolts.

3. Fasten mounting arm (Ref. #8) to drive unit with 5/16" x 1" head bolts and 5/16" lock nuts. Slip mounting arm into 3/8" square u-bolts making sure the aluminum spacer bar is behind the mounting arm. Operate toggle to place motor in the disengaged position. With the motor positioned to the left as you face the hand wheel, the motor positioned below the mounting arm, slide the mounting arm through the U-bolts until there is approximately 1/2" clearance between the outer most diameter of the large hand wheel and the bottom of the pulley groove. Tighten the 3/8" square U-bolts. (Note: The bracket installed in step one may need to be rotated on the upright post so the large hand wheel and pulley groove align with one another.)

4. Engage the grooved pulley with the hand wheel. If pulley and hand wheel do not contact sufficiently the complete unit can be moved closer to the hand wheel by loosening 3/8" square U-bolts in step 3, then reposition-

ing and tightening.

INSTALLATION ON OTHER MAKES OF HOIST

Other additional steps may be necessary to install on other brands of hoist.

IMPORTANT!

POWER SOURCE: Your new electric drive is powered by 110 volt electrical current through attached Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI).

DANGER!!!!: Water and electricity pose a potentially dangerous situation. SERVICE MUST BE SUPPLIED THROUGH A GROUND FAULT CIRCUIT INTERRUPTER (GFCI). It is recommended that a qualified electrician perform the installation of the power line equipped with a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before operating your new SSAC2 DRIVE read and understand the following instructions.

TO LOWER LIFT:

- 1. Plug in power cord into an electrical outlet to operate the SSAC2 DRIVE electric motor.
- 2. Engage drive motor wheel to hand wheel by moving lever in direction of arrow until level stops.
- 3. Hold toggle switch in "down" position lowering hoist until boat floats freely above platform.



CAUTION: DO NOT CONTINUE TO LOWER PLATFORM AFTER BOAT FLOATS FREELY.

NOTE: TO CONSERVE POWER IT IS RECOM-MENDED THAT THE DRIVE MOTOR WHEEL continued on back page


IMPORTANT: Wire selection guide.


Whenever possible, the motor should be powered from a separate branch circuit of adequate capacity to keep voltage drop to a minimum during starting and running. For longer runs, increase the wire size in accordance with the wire selection guide shown below. Never use smaller than #14 AWG (American Wire Gauge).

DECAL INSTALLATION






BE DISENGAGED AND THE HOIST PLATFORM BE LOWERED MANUALLY WITH THE LIFT WHEEL.

TO RAISE LIFT:

 Using the hoist hand wheel, manually raise the hoist platform to contact bottom of the boat so it is no longer



- Connect drive motor to SSAC2 DRIVE electric outlet source.
- 3. Engage drive motor wheel to hand wheel by moving lever in direction of arrow until lever stops.
- 4. Hold toggle switch in the "up" position until the hoist platform and boat are at the desired height. To stop movement at any time, simply release toggle switch.

CAUTION: Do not hold toggle switch in "UP" position once platform has reached the top -- this could cause damage to the hoist and to your drive motor!

DANGER! Keep hands and loose clothing away from drive wheel when operating -- personal injury could occur from contact with moving parts.

DANGER!: DO NOT OPERATE THIS UNIT FROM INSIDE BOAT OR HOIST!

CAUTION: For protection of others, always disconnect power source when hoist is left unattended.

SSAC2 TROUBLESHOOT
