System Overview

Overview: The ShoreStation 6.0 Control System gives you complete control of your ShoreStation boat lift, ShoreScreen curtain, and canopy lights via three access points: the onboard keypad, wireless remote, and ShoreStation app.

Key Components

Components:

- **Keypad** Main control interface mounted dockside, used for locking/unlocking, controlling lift, screen, and lights, tilt adjusting, and pairing devices.
- Wireless Remote Handheld control for lift, screen, lights, and tilt adjust. Operates from up to 300 feet.
- **Bluetooth App** Short-range control for all compatible equipment. Ideal for use from the dock or in the lift.
- **Controller** The electronic unit managing all signals between the keypad, remote, app, and lift components.
- **Battery Power Supply** Typically two 12V lead acid batteries in series (24VDC). In some setups, a single 12V battery is used.

System States

Wireless State (Default):

- Padlock LED on keypad: Slow flashing blue
- Lift cannot be operated from keypad, but ShoreScreen and light shortcuts are active.
- Full control from remote or app.

Unlocked State:

- Padlock LED on keypad: Solid green
- Entered by pressing red Lock button + 4-digit code.
- Full control from keypad.

Total Lock State:

- Padlock LED on keypad: Slow flashing red
- No device can operate equipment.
- Entered from either Wireless or Unlocked State by holding red Lock button for 3 seconds, then entering code.

Using the Keypad

Unlocking

- Press red Lock button, enter 4-digit code (default 1234).
- No physical key. Code replaces universal key.

Function Modes

- Mode 1: Lift
- Mode 2: ShoreScreen
- Mode 3: Canopy Lights
- Mode 4: Unused

Shortcuts in Wireless State

- Press & hold UP/DOWN = Raise/lower ShoreScreen.
- Press "3" button (light icon) = Toggle canopy lights.

Tilt Adjust

- Hold "1" button (tilt icon) + UP/DOWN.
- For permanent lifts (two cylinders). Keypad must be unlocked.

Locking Keypad

- Returns to Wireless State after 5 minutes of inactivity.
- Manually enter Wireless State by simply pressing the red LOCK button.

Set Custom 4-Digit Security Code

- Unlock keypad and hold Mode and 4 (padlock LED will slowly toggle between green and red).
- Enter custom 4-digit code. Padlock LED will confirm new code with fast-flashing red/green.

Total Lock

- Hold Lock button for 3 seconds, enter 4-digit code
- No equipment can be operated with any device until keypad is unlocked again

LED Indicator Reference (Keypad)

Padlock LED

- Slow flashing blue = Wireless
- Solid green = Unlocked
- Slow flashing red = Total Lock

Battery LED

- Solid green = $\sim 100\%$
- Flashing green = <75%
- Solid red = <50%
- Flashing red = <25%

Mode LEDs (1–4)

- Solid red = Active mode (idle)
- Flashing red = Active mode (in use)





Using the Wireless Remote

Basic Operation


- Open lid to wake.
- Starts in Mode 1 (Lift).
- Mode button cycles through Modes 1–3.
 - Active mode on the remote is independent from active mode on the keypad.
- UP/DOWN runs equipment.

Battery Indication

 Red LEDs will show remaining remote battery life for 2 seconds after opening the lid

4 lights: 75-100%
3 lights: 50-75%
2 lights: 25-50%
1 light: 0-25%

 After 2 seconds, the red LED will go back to indicating the currently active Mode



- When in "Light" Mode: Press to toggle canopy lights.
 - o Mode-Indicator LED will be slow-flashing red when in this state
- When in "Tilt-Adjust" Mode: Hold button + UP/DOWN to adjust tilt (permanent lifts only).
 - o Mode-Indicator LED will be solid red when in this state
- Toggle Between Modes: Hold Light/Tilt-Adjust + MODE for 3 seconds.

Sleep

Close lid.

Range

• Up to 300 ft in ideal conditions.

Batteries

• Remote takes two A23 batteries

Using the ShoreStation App

Connect Tab

- Lists keypads in range
- Connect to a keypad when it is in pairing mode

Light Tab

- On/Off buttons for canopy lights (if installed)
- Can be hidden in settings

Up/Down Tab

- Controls lift and/or ShoreScreen (Up and Down button for each)
- Can be hidden in settings

Lift Adjust Tab

- Permanent Lifts only
- Rotate left button and rotate right button to level the lift
- Hidden by default

PWC Lift Tab

• Not used – hidden by default

Settings Tab

- Battery Voltage
 - Shows live voltage and daily history
 - Can be used as a "load tester"
 - History is erased whenever the system loses power
- Active Equipment
 - o Toggle on/off Lift, ShoreScreen, Lights, Lift Adjust, and PWC Lift
- Light Shutoff Delay
 - o Set 5, 15, or 30 minutes auto shutoff on lights
- System Information
 - o Model, hardware, firmware info
 - o Over-the-air firmware updates

Pairing Devices

Remote

- 1. Unlock keypad.
- 2. Enter pairing mode (hold Mode + 2)
 - 1. Blue LED flashing on padlock light
- 3. Select the pairing slot position (1, 2, 3, or 4)
 - 1. Press to select, hold to clear
- 4. Press UP on remote.
 - 1. Slot LED goes solid red = paired.
- 5. Exit pairing mode: Press Mode button or wait 30 seconds for auto-exit.



Notes

- Clearing a memory slot: Enter pairing mode, hold slot number until LED shuts off.
 - 1. Example: if a slot contains a non-working remote, clear it, then re-pair it

App

- 1. Unlock keypad and enter pairing mode (hold Mode + 2)
- 2. In Connect tab, press "Find Keypad" and then "Connect" on the keypad that appears in the list
 - 1. If multiple systems appear, only the one in pairing mode will connect
- 3. Exit pairing mode on keypad (press Mode or wait 30 seconds)
- 4. Optional: Rename system in Settings > Device Name
 - 1. Quicker, personalized identification
 - 2. Default name: "ShoreStation Keypad XXXX" where XXXX is the system's unique ID

Notes

- System remembers 10 devices. Pairing an 11th clears all previous devices.
- Only one Bluetooth device can connect at a time.
 - If unable to connect, ensure no other device is connected.
- To disconnect manually, use the Disconnect button in the Connect tab.
 - Device will disconnect from system automatically when out of range
- Clearing all Bluetooth devices out of memory:
 - o Enter pairing mode
 - o Hold UP arrow until blue LED pules twice

Emergency Stop (E-Stop)

Stopping Equipment

• Press red Lock button anytime

Lockout

- Lasts 30 seconds; padlock and battery LEDs flash red
- Resets to Wireless State automatically

Tilt Adjust Function

Purpose

• For permanent lifts only, to re-level lift.

How to Tilt-Adjust

- Remote: Hold Tilt-Adjust Button (while in Tilt-Adjust State) + UP/DOWN
- Keypad: Hold "1" + UP/DOWN (when unlocked)
- App: Enable "Lift Adjust" in Settings

System Compatibility & Upgrades

Compatibility

• ShoreStation Hydraulic Lifts 5,000 lbs+

Details on Upgrading to 6.0

- New electronic components (keypad, controller box, remote)
- New motor harness (aka pump box harness)
- Keypad replaces all toggle switches and key switches

Troubleshooting

Remote not working

- Check battery, pairing slot, clear/re-pair.
- Remote takes two A23 batteries

App won't connect

• Ensure keypad in pairing mode, check Bluetooth, confirm no other device connected.

Low battery LED on keypad

Troubleshoot charging system. Charge/replace batteries.
