Prior to installation:

- a). To insure that the lift will operate properly, adequate electricity should be available. Electricity will also be needed to install the lift.
- b). Insure that the pilings are at least 12" high above the deck of the pier.
- c). The lift pilings should be driven in the ground to the dock or seawall. Otherwise the weight of the boat will pull the piles over.
- d). If existing piles are to be used, insure they are not cracked or show any signs of decay.
- e). obtain any locally required permits.

DO NOT USE ANY POWER TOOLS WHILE STANDING IN THE WATER. IF ELECTRICITY MUST BE USED NEAR THE WATER, INSURE THAT THE CIRCUIT IS PROTECTED BY A GROUND FAULT INTERRUPTER.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS MINI MAG 2800 LB. LIFT

- 1) Determine which pilings are to be used to mount the Mini Mag Lift to. Timber piles should be 8" in diameter or greater. Square piles should be 6" x 6" or greater. Both pilings must be tied back to the dock or sea wall. There should be 8' 12' maximum between piles. Ideal distance is 10'.
- 2) Mount the tracks as per figure #05. The top of the track should be 2 feet above the deck or seawall cap. It is not necessary for the track to reach the bottom. It should reach to 3' below low water. Be sure to install the 3" dock washer behind the head of the 5/8" carriage mounting bolt and the 5/8" x 1 1/2" stop bolt at the bottom of the track. The track should have a slight backward pitch. It may be necessary to install a wooden shim between the channel spacer and the track to compensate for a out of plumb piling. Figure #05.
- 3) Lubricate the stainless steel axles with a marine grease and install the poly rollers. Apply some grease to the inside walls of the track to lube the poly rollers. Clamp a set of vice grips on the lip of the track 3' down from the top of the track. Install the arms in the track and lower the arm until it rests on the vice grips.
- 4) Install the AMS 1500 with the electric motor mounts to the top of the track. Install the cable in accordance with figure #08 and the blue nylon sheave as per figure #07. Plug in the power cord. Firmly grasp the cable using leather gloves and turn the switch to the up position. Neatly wind the cable onto the drum.
- 5) Install the diagonal angle as per figure #09. Install the PVC guide bases onto the arm as close to the track as possible. Determine the width of the vessel being lifted. If the vessel is 8' wide, measure out 4' from the guide. This will be your center mark for installing the timber runners. Install the timber runners in accordance with figure #10. Initially set the runners at about 36" apart for a VEE bottom boat. That would be a 18" on either side of the center mark

IMPORTANT

Apply a good heavy grease to the winch gears. Use the two zirk fittings located on either side of the worm gear. If the gears are not lubricated after installation the lift will bind and wear the gears producing a fine powder and a scraping noise.



6) Check all nuts and bolts to be sure they are tight before fitting the boat onto the lift. Lower the lift to a depth deep enough to move the boat over the lift. Place the boat more forward so the transom extends 1' - 2' past the stern lifting arm. Raise the boat and adjust runners if required to securely hold the boat. Figure #11.

DO NOT HARDWIRE THIS LIFT OR LEAVE IT PLUGGED IN WHILE NOT IN USE TO ELECTRICAL CIRCUIT. IF THE GROUND WIRE IS ALLOWED TO REMAIN CONNECTED TO THE CIRCUIT WHILE THE LIFT IS NOT IN USE, ELECTROLYSIS WILL OCCUR. THIS WILL CORRODE THE TRACK AT A GREATLY ACCELERATED RATE.




