The Side-by-Side Dock Accessory Adapter is used only for side-by-side ShoreStation Dock layouts. The Adapter kit (DA0114) includes a mounting bracket and fasteners that attach directly to Dock Side Connector (DA0068) that is used to connect two side-by-side dock sections. This provides the option of placing dock accessories (flag pole, chair, etc) at the junction of side-by-side dock sections which is not possible with standard accessories.



The assembly process explained in this document should be performed by a qualified ShoreStation technician who understands the proper techniques and applications of the equipment used during the assembly process

Safety Definitions

Assembly Instructions


1 - Bracket Preparation

Put the $5/16-18 \times 3-1/2$ bolts through the square holes in the plate and fit the bolts around the Dock Side Connector (DA0068) as shown below.



2 - Add Bracket

Sandwich the Dockside Connector (DA0068) with the bracket and put the carriage bolts through square holes so it's level. Start the locknuts, make sure the bracket is all the way to the lower side on DA0068 (makes it easier to remove later), and tighten the locknuts.
