

We have made assembly of your new lift as simple as possible. Each bolt pack is labeled to correspond to the steps listed in this manual. Below is a list of the components included in your accessory package.

WARNING

Do not overtighten the nuts and bolts on your lift.

Doing so may cause the lift to fail. When tightening against a tube, tighten until the aluminum just dimples. Lock nuts should be tightened until at least one thread of the bolt is showing through the nut. If you crush the tube, it may crack and fail under normal use.

mainframe setup

set up the 2 mainframes with the leg sockets to the outside.



mainframe left mainframe right


mainframe spreader

bolt the mainframe spreader tube between the mainframes using:

- 3/8 x 2 1/2 hex bolts
- 3/8 flat washers
- 3/8 nylon lock nuts the holes in the spreader tube should be towards the top.

install the mainframe angle braces with:

- 5/16 x 2-1/2 hex bolts
- 5/16 flatwashers
- 5/16 nylon lock nuts place the washers under the heads of the bolts and against the tubes, put the nut against the plate or angle on the opposite side.

2. install H-units


place the 2 H-units inside the main frames and attach using:

4 - 1/2 x 4 1/2 hex bolts

12 - 1/2 flat washers

 4 - 1/2 nylon lock nuts
 place a washer under the head of the bolt, under the nut, and between

the H-unit and the mainframe.



h-unit 2 bolt package step 3 1

4. cradles

install the front and rear cradles on the top of the h-units using:

4 - 1/2 x 3 1/2 hex bolts

4 - 1/2 nylon lock nuts

install the 2 pulley assemblies in the front cradle placing one washer under the nut.


attach the cradle spreader tubes to the front and rear cradles using:

4 - angle caps - 4 1/2 long

8 - 5/16 x 6 1/2 hex bolts

8 - 5/16 flatwashers

8 - 5/16 center lock nuts




cradle front 95"	1

5. install winch

install the winch on the desired side of the lift using:

- 2 3/8 x 5 1/2 hex bolts
- 4 3/8 flat washers
- 2 3/8 nylon lock nut

6. install winch

CAREFULLY thread the 25" red wheel onto the winch shaft. The wheel should turn easily.

Fasten onto the shaft using:

- winch spring
- 1 1/2 jam lock nut

tighten the jam nut while prevent ing the winch from turning. If the winch is allowed to turn, the wheel will come off the shaft. ONLY 1 OR2THREADS SHOULD SHOW through the nylon in the nut.

turn the wheel clockwise until it tightens up against the winch and you hear the braking mechanism begin to click, when you turn the wheel counterclockwise the brake will be released, make certain the brake is activated

red wheel 25"

7. string cable

attach the cable to the mainframe opposite the winch using:

- 1 3/8 x 5 1/2 hex bolt
- 2 3/8 flat washers
- 1 1/2 flat washer
- 1 3/8 nylon lock nut

string the cable through the pulleys and secure it to the winch following the instructions included with the winch.

you may now tighten all of the nuts and bolts you have installed. Be careful not to over tighten.



carpeted bunks

attach the carpeted bunks to the front and rear cradles using:

- 4 5/16 x 1 hex bolts
- 12 5/16 center lock nuts
- 8 5/16 x 2 1/2 hex bolts
- 4 adjustment channels
- 4 channel backer plate leave all nuts loose until the final adjustment.

9. final adjustments

install the 6 red plastisol caps, 2 at the top of the mainframe and 4 on the legs.

move your lift into the water and adjust its legs so that the lift is level. Do this by removing the clevis pin, sliding the leg to the desired position, and then replacing the clevis pin and S-bend cotter.

adjust the bunks to best fit your craft, and your installation is complete

hints

- place your lift in the deepest water you can, your lift will operate more easily in deeper water.
- deep V hulls may be accommodated by moving the front of the bunks closer together and leaving the back farther apart to provide stability.

important

Your Lakeshore Jet Lift will only protect your personal watercraft if the craft is lifted well above the level of the water. In larger lakes or during storms, large waves may lift the craft from the lift or tip the lift over, causing damage both to the craft and the lift. You must take precautions to protect your craft and lift from these conditions. If your craft suffers damage from high waves, Lakeshore Products, Inc. will not accept responsibility for such damage.

Inspect your lift often for signs of wear or improper operation. Be aware of normal cranking force. Any increase in cranking force is a sign that something is wrong.

Grease the winch shaft yearly. The red wheel must be able to thread and unthread easily in order for the braking mechanism to work properly.

Pay attention to the condition of your cable. A frayed or rusted cable can lead to failure of the lift. Replace it immediately. Greasing the cable, especially where it enters the winch, can extend its life. Never over crank the winch. Once the lift has reached its highest point, further cranking will damage the lift.
